COMMISSION DIRECTIVE

Streets will be closed for the Revlon 5k Run/Walk for Women from Friday April 29, 2011 to Saturday, April 30, 2011. Accordingly, Licensees and Registrants are hereby directed to remove all commercial waste at the locations noted below before **4:00am on Saturday, April 30, 2011**. The New York City Police Department will allow private sanitation vehicles onto closed streets until 4:00am only.

Closed Streets:

- **7th Avenue from West 42nd Street to West 59th Street**
- **West 43rd Street through West 59th Street between 6th and 8th Avenues.**

Streets will be very congested because from 8:00 AM until 10:00 AM because approximately 40,000 people are expected around Times Square. Allow time for traffic when planning waste collection in the area. Customers should make arrangements to have waste collected before 4:00am. If waste cannot be collected by 4:00am, customers must store waste inside their establishment until the next scheduled waste collection.

The Commission will strictly enforce this Directive. Attempts at waste collection, and/or any waste left curbside after 4:00am on April 30, 2011 on the streets listed above will incur fines, and may be considered in evaluating the status of your company's License or Registration.
