To improve water quality in the Hutchinson River, the New York City Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is developing a Long Term Control Plan (LTCP) that will evaluate solutions to reduce combined sewer overflows (CSOs) into the waterbody.

DEP is investing approximately \$16 million dollars in Green Infrastructure in the area over the next few years to improve water quality. Join us as we discuss the impact this may have on you, the rate payers and users of the Hutchinson River and participate in a conversation on how future funds could be used to further improve water quality in the Hutchinson River.
