Review for approval drawings and submittals for construction contracts of equipment in new and rebuilt shafts along the system of City Water Tunnels. Will supervise subordinate staff and work with the Engineer in Charge of Shaft Maintenance to resolve issues of a technical nature related to the design of new and refurbished riser shafts along the system of City Water Tunnels which includes, investigating and helping to resolve technical issues associated with the design of critical components of equipment. Also under supervision perform research into the cause of recurring equipment problems and issues in existing Shaft Maintenance facilities.</p>
