Dear Dr. Young and Mr. Sweeney:

With this letter, I am submitting the following deliverables, due December 31, 2010, pursuant to EPA's July 2007 FAD:

Sections 4.09 and 4.10 of the FAD require DEP to undertake certain projects in the east of Hudson Cat/Del and Kensico basins, including construction of five stormwater practices and stabilization of the shoreline neat the Catskill Upper Effluent Chamber. These projects have been advancing through the design and permitting stages but have not yet been constructed. I am proposing that we schedule a meeting in January 2011, to review the current status and next steps for these and other FAD projects.

In addition, under separate cover I am submitting a letter providing updates on the status of projects under the Stream Management Program.
