DOs & DON'Ts

to Reduce Storm Water Pollution



DO

- Regular housekeeping and sweeping.
- Clean spills promptly with absorbents.
- Store chemicals properly and cover oily parts.
- Drain and collect all vehicular fluids.
- Inspect facilities regularly for leaks.

DON'T

- Hose down paved areas.
- Let dirt and pollutants build up.
- Let materials be exposed to storm water.
- Dump or allow liquids to enter a catch basin.
- Put off fixing any problems.
