### Staten Island Extends Drywell Audit Program Pilot - Extended to September 5, 2006

On June 5, 2006, our Staten Island office began the initial phase of a [Drywell Audit Pilot Program](#) to determine the code compliance of this type of work. Under this program, architects, engineers and contractors must notify our Staten Island office of all drywell installations in that borough. In order to collect more data, this phase of the program will be extended to September 5, 2006. The Borough Office plans to share its experiences and findings from this program with the industry as part of the process of finalizing the full scope of this initiative. This will ensure that drywell installations are performed safely and properly.
