


Proposed Street Racks Bike Parking


46th Ave & Jackson Ave, Queens

Project Background

- Existing sidewalk has tree pits and is unsuitable for sidewalk racks

- Add parking lane stripe





Example: 5th Ave and Park Pl, Brooklyn
