

Proposed Improvements

- Street Racks Bicycle Parking with space for 10 bikes
- Remove 1 car parking space on west side of street
- Add two large planter pots
- Add flexible delineators
- Add parking lane stripe
- Restrict right turns for trucks from Prince Street onto Elizabeth Street





