

# Reconstruction of Peck Slip

- Created as a park in 2009 by NYC DPR
- DPR Park ID M167; 0.19 Acres
- Reconstruction managed by the City of New York Department of Design+Construction (DDC)
- Old Seaport Alliance turning median into a public plaza (DOT & Downtown Alliance)

- Free shuttle ferry on Saturday mornings






MAP OF GOVERNORS ISLAND
