DOT

- No bollards at the Citibike Station on West 49th (8/9th Ave): **Striping needs to be done**
- Painting of pedestrian crossing at West 60 Street and Broadway: **will ask for refurbishment, can be done in spring**
- Update: lighting on West 25 Street between 6/7 Ave – Status of private contractor supplying appropriate lighting. **Illumination study done. Contractor is responsible for lighting under scaffolding**
- Update: Status of moving temporary press parking in front of 505 W 37th Street: **looking to scale back by two parking spaces**
- Update: Meeting with Midtown South regarding West 33 Street and Monroe Bus Stop permit: **the site looks feasible. It is not midtown south or transit. The permits in the vehicles are fake**
- Update: Status of 6th Avenue Bike lane extension: **has been approved, pedestrian islands will be smaller than 8th/9th and will be installed in the summer**
- Update: Status of M23 SBS Service: **A meeting at the end of the month with all the chairs and will attend committee meeting in March**

DOB

- Status of 559 West 22nd Street Demo: **no demo applications or full stop work order since July 2015**
- Update: Status of 319 West 38 Street false filing: **permits revoked; 321 in full stop work order**
- Update: Status of Inspection of Storm enclosures in CB4: **longer will be enforcing, it will be DOT, once encroachment is past 18 inches it falls under DOT**

- Update: NW corner of 6th Ave and 14th Street: **no visibility of people today**

- Unleashed dogs and adults utilizing children’s play equipment in Mathews-Palmer Park, Hell’s Kitchen Park, and Dewitt-Clinton Parks: **have not seen a problem; will be put on park enforcement list**
