



Citywide Asset and Logistics Management System

Launched in December 2003, the Citywide Asset and Logistics Management System (CALMS) is a web-based tool designed to capture information about disaster response and recovery resources.

CALMS includes modules for identifying facilities, fleet, heavy equipment, and supplies from City agencies needed during emergencies and routine operations. It also captures information about City personnel to enable emergency managers to quickly identify workers with special skill sets when they are required.

CALMS works in conjunction with the Citywide Logistics Guide, a plan developed by OEM and representatives from City and State agencies to manage the logistics process during disasters.

CALMS is the only system in New York City that integrates multiple resource management systems and provides a single view of all resources accessible to response agencies. The database also incorporates regional, state, federal, non-profit, and private sector resources. CALMS aids decision-making in the Emergency Operations Center and allows OEM to better fulfill City resource requests during emergencies.
