NYCDOB Construction Equipment Application

Overview

Purpose: The New York City Department of Buildings (NYCDOB) construction equipment application must be obtained for the use of certain construction equipment, such as chute, fence, supported scaffold, sidewalk shed, hoist, tent, grandstands, stages, etc., at a job site.

Prerequisites:

- 1) Applicant must be a New York State licensed Professional Engineer (PE) or Registered Architect (RA).
- 2) Filing representative, who is different from applicant, must be pre-registered at the NYCDOB.
- 3) A Board of Standards or Appeals (BSA) approval number or a Materials Equipment and Acceptance (MEA) approval number for the construction equipment to be used.

Submission Process:

- 1) Submit the completed PW-1 form, along with the BSA or MEA approval number for the construction equipment, at the Borough Office. Construction equipment is considered an Alteration Type 3 job in the PW-1 form.
- 2) After receiving approval on PW-1 form from NYCDOB, submit the completed PW-2 form to NYCDOB for review and approval prior to the use of the construction equipment at the job site.

Fee: \$130 each for chute and fence. \$130 for the first 25 feet of sidewalk shed plus \$10 for each additional 25 feet. \$100 for scaffold filing fee and \$30 for permit fee. \$100 for the first 1,000 square feet, plus \$0.10 for each additional square foot for other construction equipment.

Permit Timeline: Review and approval of the application can be completed by the NYCDOB within weeks.
