About BuildNYC2030

In November 2014, Mayor de Blasio announced a Career Pathways approach to workforce development in NYC to expand access to career-track jobs in fast-growing industry sectors, improve job quality and foster a more cohesive workforce system. Career Pathways emphasizes training and education, deeper connections with industry employers and a commitment to improving working conditions for the city's lower-wage workers.

BuildNYC2030 is New York City's Construction Industry Partnership, an initiative of the Career Pathways framework. Our mission is built on a threefold platform: 1) Workforce Development in Engineering and Construction 2) Capacity Building for Minority Women Business Enterprises (M/WBE), and 3) Construction Innovation. We are a collaboration of engineering and construction firms, construction unions, trade associations and community based organizations, government, educational/academic institutions and training providers designed to support the growth of NYC's construction ecosystem.

Job Description

BuildNYC2030 is seeking a Director of Strategy and Initiatives. The Director will rely heavily on strategic and data driven approaches to designing and implementing new initiatives; will develop and manage project plans, schedules, deliverables and assessments—assuring that programs are fully aligned with overall strategic intent.

Reporting to the Founding Executive Director, this position's immediate and primary focus will be the creation of sustainable workforce pipelines for high-need professional construction administrative and management occupations and construction build careers. The Director of Strategy and Initiatives will work in collaboration with industry stakeholders to deliver results-driven training and job opportunities at scale to thousands of New Yorkers.

The Director of Strategy and Initiatives must be highly intelligent, a skilled systems thinker and consensus builder, and have a passion for improving the lives of New Yorkers and the built environment of NYC.

Responsibilities:

- Guide strategy development and implementation
- Assist with research, define benchmarks, track outcomes and assess efficacy of efforts
- Oversee program development as directed including RFP's, contracts and evaluations
- Manage day-to-day implementation of BuildNYC2030 initiatives including events, programs and efforts to guide systems change
- Synthesize complex information into memos, presentations and reports for various audiences
- Support marketing and communications efforts
- Manage ongoing cultivation and needs of key stakeholders and industry leaders
