### HEARINGS RESUME MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2001 AT TLC TRIBUNAL LOCATED AT LONG ISLAND CITY TLC'S FREE EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION SERVICE PROGRAM: DISCONTINUATION OF SELECTED SITES

#### MAYOR RUDOLPH W. GIULIANI ESTABLISHES THE TWIN TOWERS FUND

Hearings scheduled for the TLC Adjudications Tribunal at Long Island City with TLC Inspectors and Investigators will resume on Monday, September 24, 2001. The Hearings will be conducted at the TLC Tribunal located at 32-02 Queens Boulevard in Long Island City, and will be held at the date and time on the summons or notice of hearing. TLC hearings involving New York City Police Officers will continue to be adjourned until further notice.

TLC announces that the TLC Free Emergency Transportation Service Program operating from the following locations have been discontinued, effectively immediately:

- Bellevue Hospital Center, located at First Avenue and 27th Street
- NYU Medical Center, located at 560 First Avenue
- St. Lukes-Roosevelt Hospital, located at Tenth Avenue/59th Street
- Red Cross Blood Bank, located at 310 East 67th Street between First and Second Avenues

In addition, Free Emergency Transportation from the following locations will be discontinued, effective 6:00 P.M., Friday, September 21st:

- Beth-Israel Medical Center, located on First Avenue, and 16th Street
- Cabrini Medical Center, 227 East 19th Street

Please refer to the attached table for complete details of the sites that will remain in service for the provision of free transportation.
