EMERGENCY COMMUTER VAN AUTHORIZATION TO PICK UP/DROP OFF ALONG B100, Q6, Q10, Q11 AND Q40 ROUTES IN BROOKLYN AND QUEENS IS RESCINDED

Effective immediately, the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) hereby rescinds the temporary authority waiving Commuter Van rules 9-10(d), 9-10(e)(1), and 9-10(e)(2), which had been granted by the TLC Chairman during this week's work action. All TLC rules are in full force and effect.
