#### **MEDALLION TRANSFERS TO BE PROCESSED BY TLC DIVISION OF LEGAL AFFAIRS, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2002**

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) announces that medallion transfer applications will be processed by the TLC Division of Legal Affairs, effective July 1, 2002.

The Division of Legal Affairs (Legal Department) is located within the TLC's Administrative Headquarters at 40 Rector Street, 5th Floor, New York, New York 10006.

The TLC Legal Department will accept applications for the transfer of medallions by appointment only. Brokers, agents and licensees may call (212) 676-1135 to schedule an appointment. After the transfer application has been received and reviewed, the parties will be given a date and time for a closing. Closings will also be conducted at 40 Rector Street, 5th Floor.
