#### MEDALLION DRIVER JOB FAIR OFFERS TRUE ONE-STOP SHOPPING FOR PROSPECTIVE HACKS

A job fair will be held on Tuesday, May 25, 2004 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Masonic Hall Building, located at 71 West 23<sup>rd</sup> Street (at 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue) in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor banquet room. The event offers those interested in a career in the thriving medallion taxicab industry an excellent opportunity to work with representatives from both the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) and the medallion taxicab industry to accelerate the hack licensing process. The event's primary sponsor is the Metropolitan Board of Trade (MTBOT).

The TLC will be onsite to allow the processing of participants' applications that day. License applicants will also have the opportunity to be fingerprinted, drug tested, complete the medical exam and sign up for taxi school all while attending the job fair. Licensing staff will be available to assist with the process, and many representatives from taxicab fleets will be on hand to answer any questions about their operations, and the industry as a whole.

In order to expedite the licensing process, job fair attendees are reminded to bring proof of citizenship or residency, an original social security card, New York State driver's license (NJ and CT licensees need a state abstract dated within 30 days), and proof of address. The TLC encourages anyone interested in learning more about a career in the medallion taxicab industry, and beginning the hack license application process, to attend the job fair.
