- Your TLC driver’s license
- Your state issued Department of Motor Vehicle driver’s license. If your D.M.V. license does not display your photo, bring your temporary DMV license and additional identification displaying a photograph of yourself with your signature.
- Your Social Security Card
- You must bring payment for the course. Please call the school of your choice for the cost.
