The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission announces that under the terms of rule 59A-35(d) and rule 59B-35 (h) (http://www.nyc.gov/html/tlc/downloads/pdf/2011rulebook_ch59.pdf), a Point Reduction Program is now available. Attendance at this course, subject to the guidelines listed below, will remove one (1) penalty point accrued on a For-Hire Vehicle License or a Base License.

- Licensees will have the option of taking the course at any time during the term of their license. Upon completion of the course one (1) point will be removed from the licensee's point total.
- The course is four (4) hours.
- The point reduction earned for taking and completing the course cannot be banked or carried over. If a licensee takes and completes the course but has no points assessed against their license their point total remains at zero. A negative point total will not be allowed.
- A licensee can only take the point reduction course once (1x) during the term of their license for point reduction purposes.
- Licensee may take the course up until the issuance of the final point that results in the revocation of their license and have a point removed from their license. Once a license is revoked they cannot take the course.
- Course option is not available to the licensee if an appeal of a revocation is in process. If the appeal is determined to have merit and the revocation is reversed then the course can be taken.
- Person(s) required to attend:
 - Corporation – any officer*
 - Partnership – one of named partners*
 - Individual – owner*
