## **TLC Retracts Industry Notice #12-10, Dated March 28, 2012**

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) requests that you **please disregard previously issued Industry Notice #10 dated March 28, 2012** regarding replacement of the Temporary Purple & Yellow “Poker Chip” Decal Stickers

While the TLC-issued temporary “poker chip” decals expire on April 1, 2012 as long as the vehicle permit is current and valid the Temporary Decals affixed to the vehicle can remain on the vehicle until your next scheduled inspection.

The stickers DO NOT have to be replaced at this time.

It is not necessary for owners to bring their vehicles into our Woodside facility to have them replaced. There will be no enforcement taken by the TLC against any vehicle owner for having the Temporary Decals on their vehicle, as long as the vehicle license is valid.

The Temporary Decals will be replaced in the normal course of business when the vehicle comes in for their next scheduled visual or full DMV inspection. No additional trip to Woodside is required.
