

For livery and black car passengers:




Starting summer 2009, livery and black car vehicles will look different to you.

We passed new rules that require this decal to be displayed on both of the rear quarter windows – one on each window.

You should only get into a vehicle if you can see this decal. They show you the car is licensed by TLC.

How to know you are getting into a TLC-licensed livery car

- You should see stickers on the outside of the car that have information about the car's base.
- You will find the stickers either:
 1. On both sides of the car
 2. On the back of the car
 3. Or on both sides of the car and on the back of the car



If the stickers are on the side of the car:

Stickers must have:

1. The base name
2. The base license number
3. The base telephone number

● Look for the TLC decal (pictured above) on the rear quarter windows. This lets you know it is licensed.

If the stickers are on the back of the car:

Stickers must have:

1. The base name
2. The base license number
3. The base telephone number
