

Vision Zero Base Report Glossary

To receive a report, a for-hire vehicle (FHV) base must have applied for a TLC license by September 1, 2015 and maintained an average of at least 10 affiliated vehicles during the reporting period (July-December 2015). All types of FHV bases—livery, black car, and luxury limousine—receive a report.

Safety*

- **Fatal Crashes:** All collisions involving a TLC-licensed vehicle affiliated with the base at the time of the crash resulting in a fatality (on-duty and off-duty). When a fatal crash is listed, the TLC action in those cases is listed, as well.
- **Injury Crashes:** All collisions involving a TLC-licensed vehicle affiliated with the base at the time of the crash resulting in an injury of any severity (major and minor injuries; on-duty and off-duty; irrespective of fault).
- **Vehicle Safety Violations:** A count of summonses naming vehicles affiliated to a base at the time the violation was issued and where the violator plead or was found guilty. Violations included in this metric fall into three categories: unlicensed activity, insurance requirements, and vehicle condition.
- **Base Safety Violations:** A count of summonses sent to bases, where the violating base plead or was found guilty. Violations included in this metric fall into four categories: accountability (e.g., trip data submission), accessibility, unlicensed activity, and vehicle condition.

Vehicles

- **Affiliated Vehicles:** Average number of vehicles affiliated with the base during the report period. This number is used for all per-vehicle calculations in the report.
- **Average Vehicle Age:** An average of the age (in years) of all affiliated vehicles during the report period, determined through TLC vehicle licensing information.
- **Top Vehicle Models:** The top five most common vehicle models among a business' affiliated vehicles based on average affiliation data.

Badges



- **On-Demand Service:** This business provides on-demand service to customers. (Self-reported)
- **Book in Advance:** This business allows customers to book trips in advance. (Self-reported)
- **Green Taxi Service:** This business provides street hail service through green Boro taxis.
- **Honor Roll Base:** This business is a member of the 2015 TLC Safety Honor Roll.
- **Honor Roll Drivers:** Number of drivers affiliated to the business who were members of the 2015 TLC Safety Honor Roll at the time of the ceremony in September 2015.
- **Vision Zero Training:** This business has hosted TLC staff for a meeting to discuss Vision Zero and safe driving tips with drivers.
- **Vehicle Safety Technology:** Vehicles affiliated with this base have some form of vehicle safety technology, such as black boxes, cameras, or driver alert systems. This list includes both official TLC Vehicle Safety Technology Pilot participant vehicles as well as self-reported use of this kind of technology.
- **Base Safety Program:** Businesses were invited to share if they provide other safety training programs beyond TLC and City requirements. (Self-reported)
- **Alt-Fuel Vehicles:** Percentage of vehicles affiliated to a base that have hybrid or electric engines or are models TLC has been alerted to that use alternative fuel.
- **Accessible Vehicles:** Percentage of Boro Taxis affiliated to a base that is wheelchair-accessible.

*These statistics are calculated on a per-vehicle basis based on the total average vehicles affiliated to the business.
