

Upper East Side Group Ride Stands

Current Location:

- Northbound side of York Avenue at E. 79th St. corner

New, Additional Location:

- Northbound side of York Ave. mid-block between E. 70th & E. 71st St.

How Group Rides Work

1. To use the Upper East Side Group Ride taxi stands, you must be willing to wait for at least two passengers to enter your taxi. *If requested, you must take non-group ride passengers to their desired destination from these stands.*
2. The stands are in operation Monday through Friday, 7 AM - 10 AM.
3. Passengers you pick up from the Upper East Side group ride stands may exit along your route beginning at Pearl Street, continuing along Water Street to the World Financial Center. (See suggested route map)
4. You must use the FDR Drive South to Pearl Street.
5. You may not pick-up additional passengers along the route.
6. You must use your meter for group rides.
7. *Fare is \$6/passenger. Fare includes all tolls, taxes, and surcharges*

How to Use the Meter for Group Rides

1. Press Code 6 on meter or Driver Information Monitor screen (DIM) (varies by meter model).
2. Select group ride fare rate - It will be listed as \$6 or \$5.50 + 0.50t state surcharge, depending on meter model.
3. Enter the number of passengers.
4. You may have to rehire the meter for each passenger who wants to pay with a credit/debit card.
5. State surcharge applies once to the trip, not to each passenger.
